Text: Proverbs 12:18; 25:11;

Introduction: To master our mouths, we must first consider...

- **I.** The Uncontrolled Mouth The book of Proverbs gives us at least three ways to identify an uncontrolled mouth...
 - A. It is a lying mouth Proverbs 6:16-17, 19; John 14:6; 1 Peter 2:21-22;
- B. It is a gossiping mouth Proverbs 18:8; Matthew 12:36; Proverbs 17:9; 1 Peter 4:8; James 3:2;
- C. It is a cursing, or profaning, mouth Proverbs 4:24; Exodus 20:7; Ephesians 4:29; Ephesians 5:4;
- **II.** How to Master Your Mouth There are at least four things we must do to master our mouths:
 - A. Always be candid Proverbs 24:26; Proverbs 27:6; Ephesians 4:15;
 - B. Always be confidential Proverbs 11:13;
 - C. Always be constructive Proverbs 16:24; Proverbs 25:11;
 - D. Always be constrained Proverbs 18:13; Proverbs 26:4;

Conclusion:

The uncontrolled mouth is a lying mouth, a gossiping mouth, and a cursing mouth.
