αρχή arche (ar-khay)

Jesus the Christ, God the Son, the second person of the Triune Godhead was already in existence when the heavens and the earth were created.

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.





Translated as "was" is describing continuous action in the past and by it use, it then reinforces the eternal nature of the Word.

Λόγος LOGOS (log'-os)

To Greek philosophers logos represented the abstract principle of reason and order in the universe.

This means that everything that can be said about God the Father can be said about God the Son.
