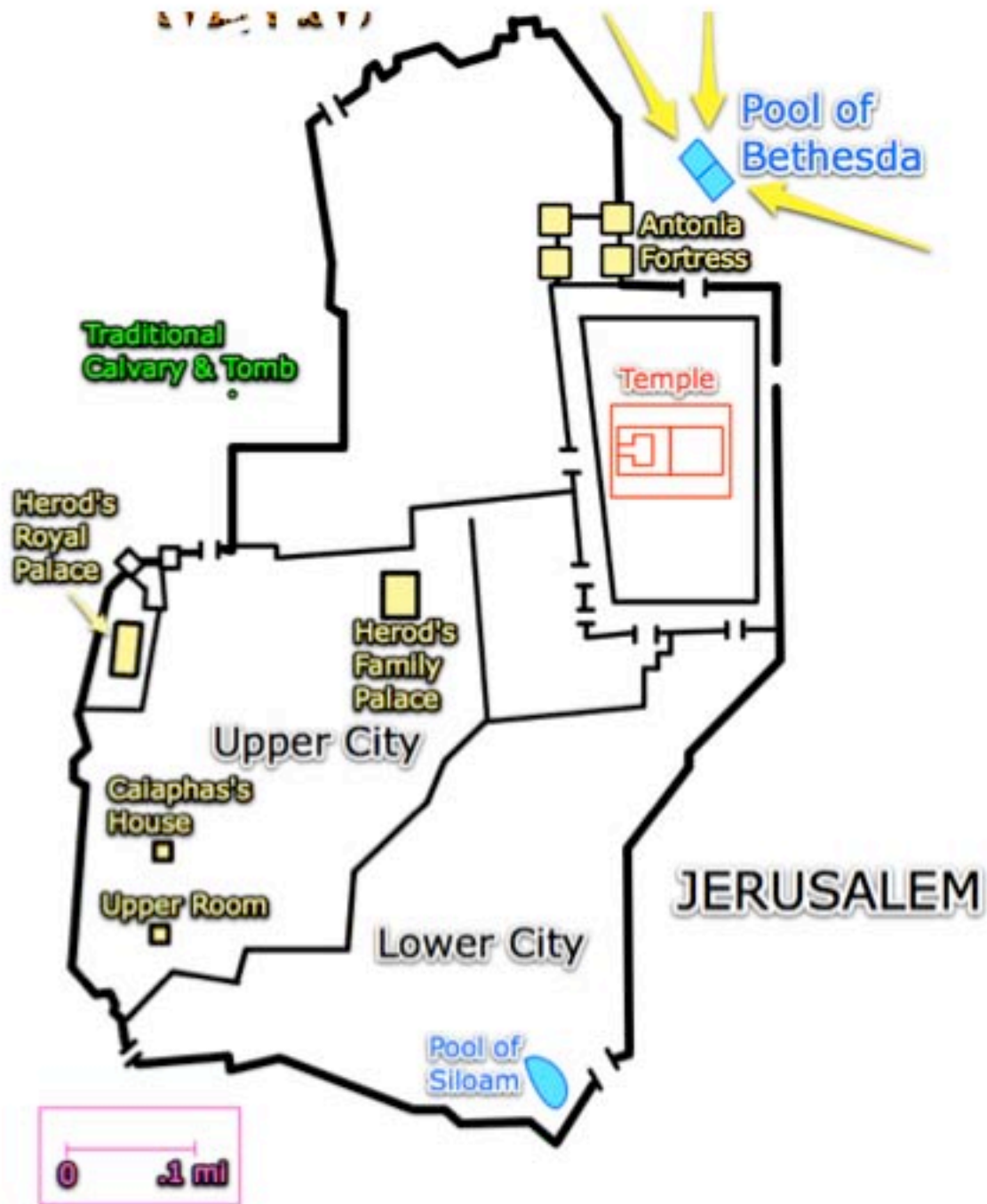
***Passover or Unleavened Bread***

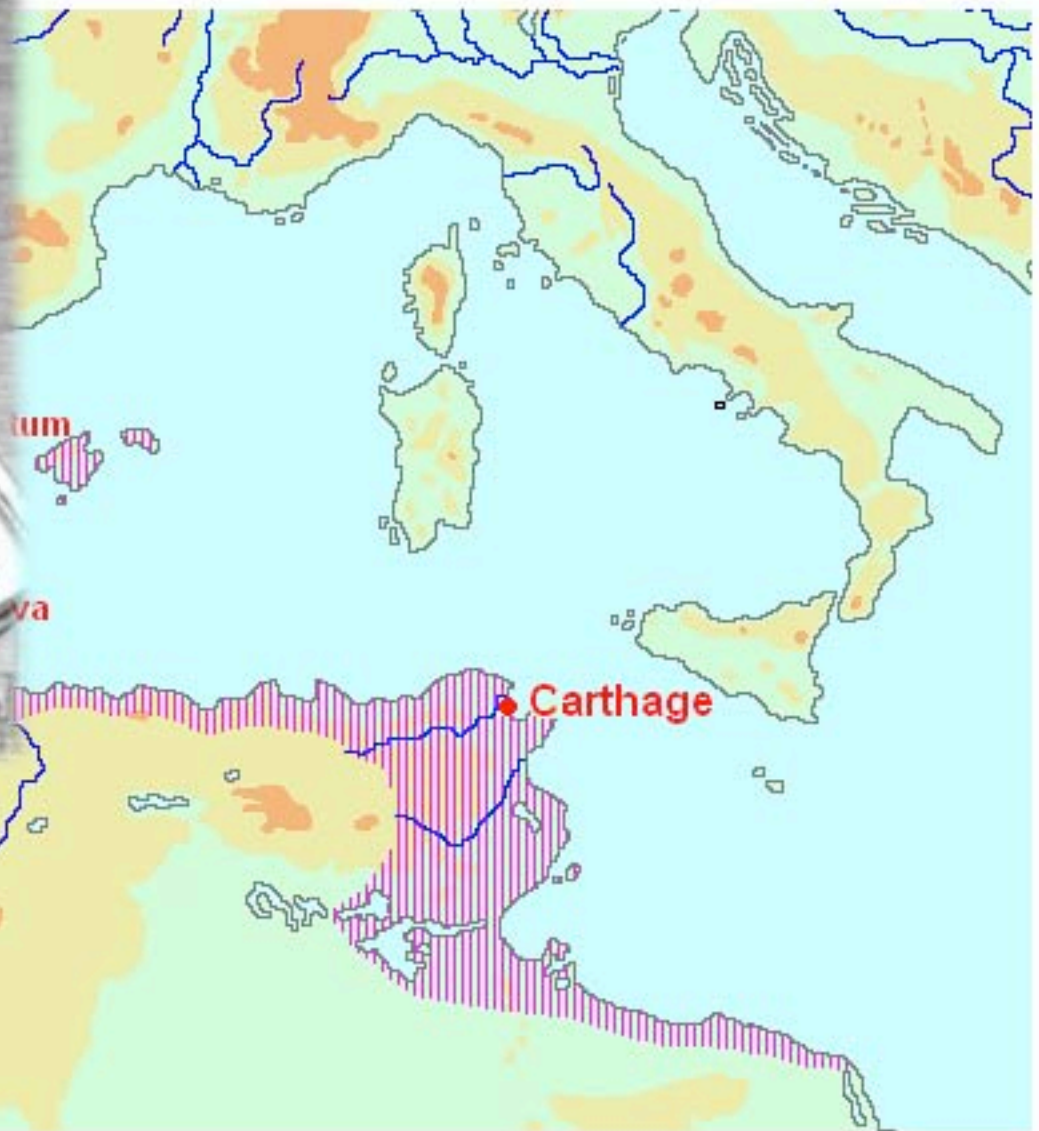


"The Pool of Siloam In Jerusalem"
