Our Father



Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect. – Matthew 5:48

What did God have in mind when He created the human male? The world around us offers many images of what it means to be a "real man." The world offers us the breadwinner, the tough-guy and the workaholic's

unending push for success. Also, it's becoming increasingly universal that it is the woman who holds the family together. We can be sure that none of these images capture what God had in mind.

His Word of grace in the forgiveness of sins through Jesus Christ assures all who cling to Christ that the perfect and almighty God is truly our Father!
