
When His disciples James and John saw this, they said, "Lord, do You want us to command fire to come down from heaven and consume them?"

Your father Abraham rejoiced to see My day, and he saw it and was glad.


Unless the speaker is God, this is really so preposterous as to be comic.

As the sun shines on the swamp it will call forth malaria: but the fault is not in the sun, but in the ground. The very same rays call forth fertility from the grain-fields...

... So the truth of God will yield spiritual fruit from a believing heart, but from the carnal mind it will evoke endless cavil and blasphemy. Some thought Christ a good man; others regarded Him as a deceiver: sufficient for the disciple to be as His Master.

So because you are lukewarm, and neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of My mouth.


