Acts Chapters 10-12 Question and Answers

1. In Acts 10:1-8ff, we are told of Cornelius and how he is instructed to send for Peter that "...he shall tell thee what thou oughtest to do."

Using the Scripture in this chapter, how long did it take the servants of Cornelius to get to Joppa and return?



Jaffa is 51.5 kilometers (32 miles) from Sedot Yam, a hotel in Caesarea. (http://www.evi.com/ q/distance_between_joppa_and_caesarea)

Acts 10:9 "On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city"..., 23. Then called he them in, and lodged them. And on the morrow Peter went away with them, and certain brethren from Joppa accompanied him. 24 And the morrow after they entered into Caesarea."

My examination revealed that they were three days in their mission to get to Joppa, retrieve Peter and return to Caesarea.

2. Using the same <u>verses</u> (1-44) list the involvement of God in bringing Cornelius to Salvation. A. Verse 3. God gave "He saw in a vision..."

B. God gave specific directions; Verses5-6;

C. God prepared Peter with a video in which He spoke to Peter apparently THREE times. Verses 10-16;

D. In verse 19-20 God again speaks to Peter assuring him to obey the request of these men from Cornelius. E. Verse 34. "Then Peter opened his mouth...Verse 43... "that through his name whosoever believeth in him shall receive remission of sins."

F. Acts 10:44 "While Peter yet spake these words, the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word." 3. In Acts chapter 11. Peter is restating what occurred in Cornelius' home; what does he call the fact that the "Holy Spirit fell" on these gentiles?

Verse16 "Then remembered I the word of the Lord, how that he said, John indeed baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost."
