

VIRTUES GIVEN BY GOD John 16:25-33 7.12.15

1. *“So now faith, hope, and love abide, these three; but the greatest of these is **LOVE**.”* (1 Corinthians 13:13)
2. God is a God of truth, as the Prophet Samuel declared, *“O Lord God, you are God and your words are true.”* (1 Samuel 7:28) God is unable to **LIE**.
3. In the Old Testament, the word “**HOLY**” means set apart for God by God, and in the New Testament it means dedicated or consecrated to the service of God.
4. *“Do you not see that whatever goes **INTO** the mouth passes into the stomach and is expelled? But what comes **OUT** of the mouth proceeds from the heart, and this defiles a person.”* (Matthew 15:17-18)
