CHRIST'S BETRAYAL

John 18:1-11

- 1. John's purpose in writing the gospel: "...these have been written that you may believe that Jesus is the __CHRIST___, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name." John 20:31
- 2. Jesus came to earth for one reason: to die, to pay for ___SIN___, all _SIN____, that people can be reconciled with God.
- 3. In reading Isaiah we see the purpose of God the Father. We see that God has all knowledge and had a plan for our salvation since <u>BEFORE</u> the creation of the universe.
- 4. The Garden of Gethsemane was a common meeting place for Jesus and His disciples. Judas __KNEW____ this place well and that Jesus would be found here.
- 5. The Roman tribune sent 200 to __600__ soldiers with the Jewish officers to arrest Jesus, thus preventing an uprising among the people of Jerusalem.
- 6. In Exodus God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM". When Jesus was being arrested, twice He used the same name for Himself that God used in identifying Himself to Moses. He answered, "I told you that _I__ AM___." John 18:6 & 8
- 7. Peter was emboldened by Jesus' show of authority and power when hundreds of men ____FELL____to the ground at the words "I AM", but he still did not understand that Jesus needed to die for the salvation of those called by God.
- 8. Jesus is still teaching that He must be obedient to His Father just as the disciples need to be obedient to ____HIM_. And we are to be obedient to Christ.

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
