




Blessed Dying


And all these, though commended through their faith, did not receive what was promised, since God had provided something better for us, that apart from us they should not be made perfect.

Blessed Assurance






Do not fear what you are about to suffer... Be faithful unto death, and I will give you the crown of life... The one who conquers will not be hurt by the second death.
