

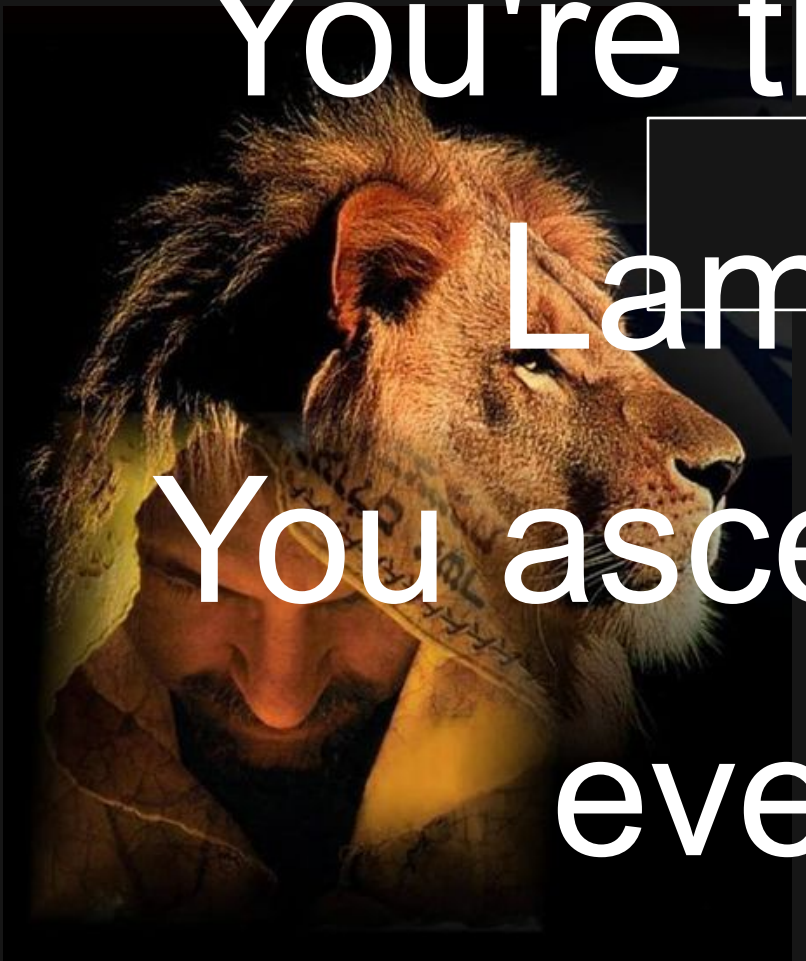

And the angels will cry

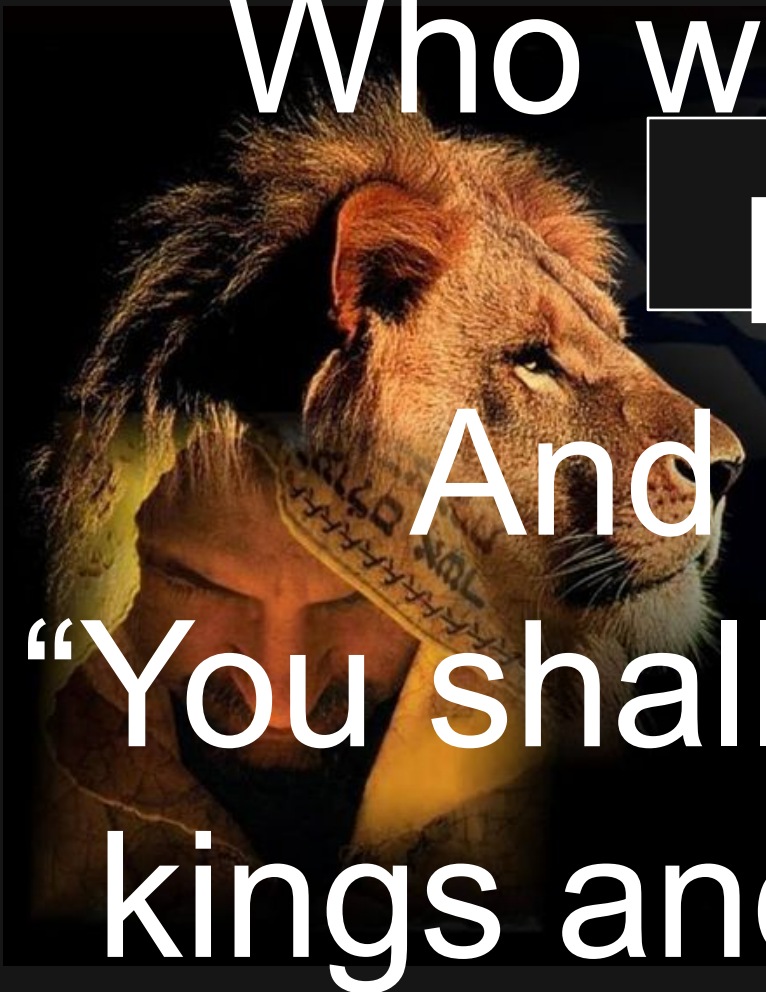
