in me**


**From life's first cry to final

Your face


Bearing the awesome weight of

cross



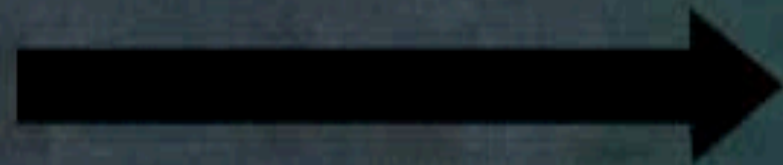
