OF FAITH AND DISOBEDIENCE: Part 3 Hosea 2:14-23

- 1. The first half of chapter two of Hosea focuses on the <u>DEFECTION</u> of Israel, the bride, away from God as illustrated by Gomer's desertion of Hosea. Like Gomer, Israel worshiped false gods.
- 2. "You shall have no other gods before me... You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the LORD your God am a <u>JEALOUS</u> God." Exodus 20:3, 5
- 3. Life has its <u>VALLEYS</u>, those times that haunt our memories of failure and sin. These can prevent us from seeing God's vision for our future.
- 4. "I am the <u>DOOR</u>. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have life and have it abundantly." John 10:9-10
- 5. The cross and resurrection is our door of <u>HOPE</u>. When we pass through, we are forgiven and begin to grow closer to God until we join him in heaven forever.
- 6. "My hope is built on nothing less than Jesus' <u>BLOOD</u> and righteousness. I dare not trust the sweetest frame but wholly lean on Jesus' name." Pastor Edward Mote, 1834
- 7. "And she will <u>SING</u> there as in the days of her youth, as in the day when she came up from the land of Egypt." Hosea 2:15b (NASB)
- 8. "Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and <u>OPENS</u> the door, I will come in to him and eat with him, and he with me." Revelation 3:20
- 9. "The words of the holy one, the true one, who has the key of David, who opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens. I know your works. Behold, I have set before you an open door, which no one is able to SHUT. I know that you have but little power, and yet you have kept my word and have not denied my name." Revelation 3:7, 8
- 10. "I will sow her for myself in the land. And I will have <u>MERCY</u> on No Mercy, and I will say to Not My People, 'You are my people; and he shall say, 'You are my God.'" Hosea 2:23
