John MacArthur mobile study bible: Nahum means "comfort" or "consolation and is a short form of Nehemiah ("comfort of Yahweh").

The Preachers commentary: Nahum an Elkoshite of the tribe of Simeon from the city of Elkosh.

Nineveh abused God's people and now put to an end.

The heart dissolves in fear and loses faith in trouble or temptation. 1 Corinth. 10: 13

Fall of Nineveh, annillation, never to rise again. Triumph of Christ.

Yet He is good, a fortress in the day of trouble, "and He knowneth them that trust in Him"

His fierce and righteous anger who can withstand. For it is poured out like liquid fire that spreads and destroys. The hard hearts, like rocks in man are thrown down.

All creation must own His power, and all elements yield to His authority.

Exodus 34:5-7, Num. 21:6-9, John 3:14-15

Warning to the hard hearted with judgement to come. But to the believer in the whirlwind and storm and clouds are a sign of God's presence and comforted by faith.

Our enemies are His enemies, by faith that helps with our worry or anxieties.

Chapter 1 presents the eternal one as the rock and stay of those who confide in Him.

2 Thess. 1:6-10

John Calvin Commentary: Though GOD connives (to close eyes in sleep, turn a blind eye) at the wickedness of man? He will yet be the defender of His Glory. When he says that God keeps for His enemies, He means that vengeance is reserved for the unbelieving and dispisers of God, He proclaims war against the Ninevites, because they had unjustly distressed the church of God.

The Israelites might feel assured that this calamity was seriously announced.

They might have reasoned with themselves.

We are indeed cruelly harassed by our enemies; but who can think that God cares anything for our miseries, since He allows them so long to be unavenged?

God does not hasten so very quickly, there is no ground for us to yhink that He is indifferent,

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because He delays His wrath or retains it, as we have already said; for it is the same thing to retain wrath, as to be the Lord of wrath and possess it.

Exodus 34; Psalm 18; Joel 3

Patiently defers and suspends the punishment which the ungodly deserve.

Passage through the red sea is not here referred to; but that the object is to show in general how great is God's power in governing the whole world.

As soon as God shows His wrath, the rivers will dry up, the sea itself will become dry, and then the flowers will fade and the grass will wither.

All things will be reduced to solitude and desolation whenever God is angry.

As soon, then, as God is angry, the mountains melt like snow, and flow away like water.

His wrath like fire, is poured out consumes everything and as the earth quakes the rocks and building foundations are thrown down.

The heart of man, rock hard will be broken down or dissolved.

- . Though God then is armed with vengeance against His enemies He yet ceases not to be like Himself, nor does He forget His goodness.
- . Help the faithful, and in time alleviate their miseries.
- . "God is ever ready to bring help to His people".
- . He may subject His people to the cross and to troubles, He still helps them.
- . God leaves many destitute who profess to believe in Him, He justly witholds from them His favor, for they do not from the heart call on Him or seek Him.
- . Hypocrites may know that they are not assisted, because their profession is nothing else but hypocrisy, for they hope not sincerely in God, however they may falsely boast of His name. Complete destruction with no recovery and rising up again. Complete darkness-nothing.

The Nature Of God, A.W. Pink: general mercy of God, extended not only to all men, believers and unbelievers alike, but also to the entire creation: "His tender mercies are over all his works"; He giveth to all life, and breath, and all things.

Grace Gems.org; Johnathan Edwards 1750: The cause and cure of earthquakes! God does not turn away in anger, dreadful darkness, mountains quake and the earth heaves, earthquakes and volcanoes appear with smoke and flames. Rocks are broken up and out comes the flames and smoke of His wrath.

The nature of GOD and Systematic theology Wayne Grudem: The wrath of GOD is a perfection of the divine character upon which we need to frequently meditate and God's wrath a character of GOD.
