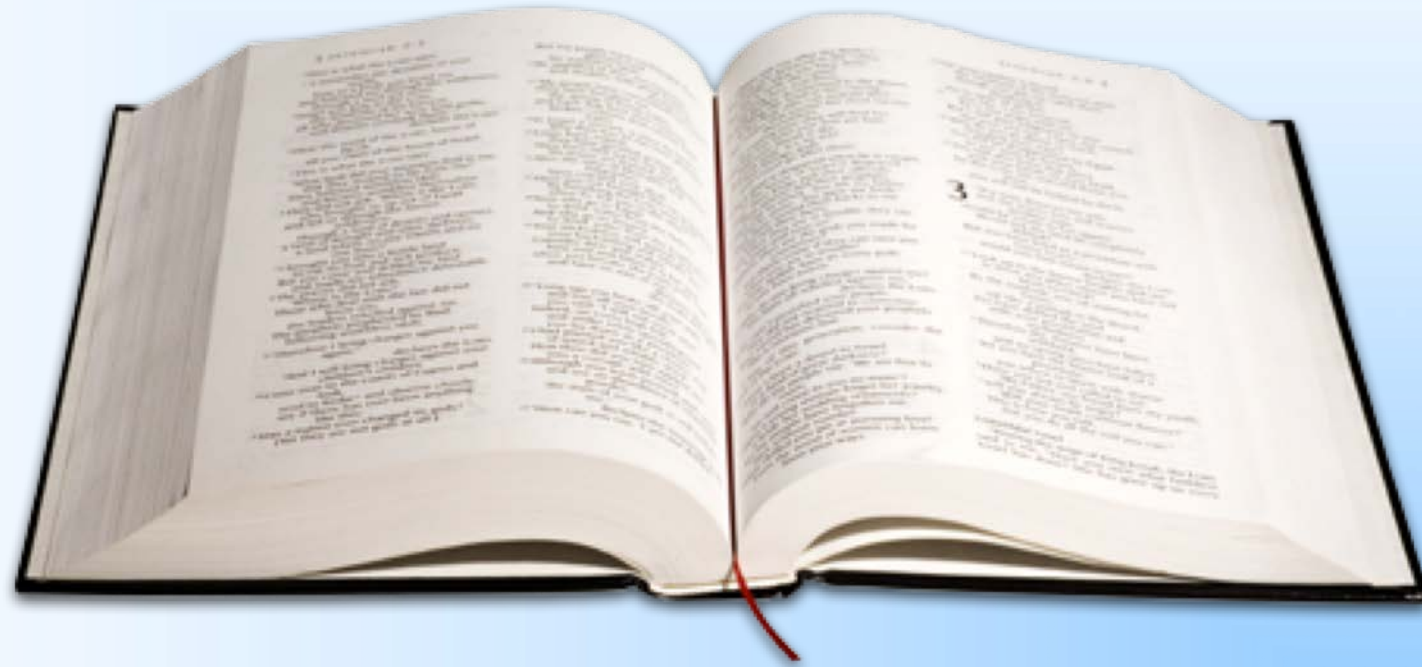

# The Remnant

*Joseph* did as the angel of the Lord commanded him: he took his wife, but knew her not until she had given birth to a son.





A single witness shall not suffice against a person for any crime or for any wrong in connection with any offense that he has committed. Only on the evidence of two witnesses or of three witnesses shall a charge be established.





But if he does not listen, take one or two others along with you, that every charge may be established by the evidence of two or three witnesses.
