The promise of spiritual rest is secured by faith in Jesus still stands

Also there is the promise of one being denied eternal rest because of their unbelief in Jesus.



A Rest Denied Because of Unbelief

Hebrews 4:1-2

We should fear,

therefore, while the promise of entering his rest still stands, let us fear lest any of you should seem to have failed to reach it.

They have ears, but do not hear.

For all the Prophets and the Law prophesied until John, and if you are willing to accept it, he is Elijah who is to come. He who has ears to hear, let him hear.

Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey; but I will not go up among you, lest I consume you on the way, for you are a stiff-necked people.

For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse.

ROMANS 10:14-17

How then will they call on him *meaning Jesus* in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!" (Isaiah 52:7) But they have not all obeyed the gospel. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed what he has heard from us?" (Isaiah 53:1) So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.

HEBREWS 12:1-2

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

MATTH EW 7:21-23

Not everyone who says to me, "Lord, Lord," will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven. On that day many will say to me, "Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?"
