

Journey Into Success How To Experience a Miracle

TEXT: Joshua 3:1-5;

Please Open Your Bibles and read along with me.

Joshua 3:1-5 "Then Joshua rose early in the morning and they set out from Shittim. And they came to the Jordan, he and all the people of Israel, and lodged there before they passed over. 2 At the end of three days the officers went through the camp 3 and commanded the people, "As soon as you see the ark of the covenant of the Lord your God being carried by the Levitical priests, then you shall set out from your place and follow it. 4 Yet there shall be a distance between you and it, about 2,000 cubits in length. Do not come near it, in order that you may know the way you shall go, for you have not passed this way before." 5 Then Joshua said to the people, "Consecrate yourselves, for

tomorrow the Lord will do wonders among you."

Introduction:

Try to remember an exciting day in your life, a day for which you have waited a long time.

It might be your first bicycle, your driver's license, or your first car.

Maybe it is your first date or the day you married that special person.

For years you have waited, and suddenly it arrives.

It was just such a day when the Israelites were finally ready to enter the Promised Land.

Five hundred years earlier God made Abraham this promise:

Genesis 15:18 "In the same day the LORD made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river **Euphrates:"**



After waiting 500 years the Israelites are camped seven miles east of the Jordan river.

Joshua 3:1-2 "And Joshua rose early in the morning; and they removed from Shittim, and came to Jordan, he and all the children of Israel, and lodged there before they passed over. 2 And it came to pass after three days, that the officers went through the host;"

In this passage we see three prerequisites for experiencing a miracle.

- I. Prepare For A Miracle Joshua 3:3-8;
- II. Believe God's Word Joshua 3:9-13;
- III. Act In Faith Joshua 3:14-17;

I. Prepare For A Miracle

Joshua 3:6-8 "And Joshua spake unto the priests, saying, Take up the ark of the covenant, and pass over before the people. And they took up the ark of the covenant, and went before the people. 7 And the LORD said unto Joshua, This day will I begin to magnify thee in the sight of all Israel, that they may know that,

as I was with Moses, so I will be with thee. 8 And thou shalt command the priests that bear the ark of the covenant, saying, When ye are come to the brink of the water of Jordan, ye shall stand still in Jordan."

God has given His promise to Joshua and the Israelites and now it is time for a test.



A. Follow the ARK of the Covenant -

Joshua 3:3 "And they commanded the people, saying, When ye see the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the priests the Levites bearing it, then ye shall remove from your place, and go after it."

Regardless of the difficulties.

Swollen River -

Joshua 3:15 "And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,)"





The Ark of the covenant was kept in in the innermost room of the tabernacle and later in the temple.

Exodus 25:22 "And there I will meet with thee, and I will commune with thee from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubims which are upon the ark of the testimony, of all things which I will give thee in commandment unto the children of Israel."

The Ark OF The Covenant represents the presence of God among His people.

When the Israelites followed the Ark of the covenant they were following GOD.



1. Wait on the Lord -

Psalms 27:14 "Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD."

2. Wait in FAITH -

Hebrews 11:6 "But without faith it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him."

Isaiah 40:31 "But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint."

2 Timothy 3:12 "Indeed, all who desire to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted," (ESV)

Joshua 3:5 "And Joshua said unto the people, Sanctify yourselves: for tomorrow the LORD will do wonders among you."

B. Sanctify Yourselves

Colossians 3:8-9 "But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth. 9 Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds:"

The "wonders" mentioned in Joshua 3:5 are the miracles most believers fail to experience in their lives because they hold on to "PET" sins.

It may be a terrible habit, a wrong relationship, refusing to follow the Lord in baptism, or not putting GOD FIRST in your life.

It is only when we "sanctify" ourselves that we will be prepared for God to work a miracle in our lives.

Joshua 3:6 "And Joshua spake unto the priests, saying, Take up the ark of the covenant, and pass over before the people. And they took up the ark of the covenant, and went before the people."

If you want to experience a Miracle, Prepare for a miracle and then...

II. Believe God's Word

Joshua 3:9-13 And Joshua said unto the children of Israel, Come hither, and hear the words of the LORD your God. 10 And Joshua said, Hereby ye shall know that the living God is among you, and that he will without fail drive out from before you the Canaanites, and the Hittites, and the Hivites, and the Perizzites, and the Girgashites, and the Amorites, and the Jebusites. 11 Behold, the ark of the covenant of the Lord

of all the earth passeth over before you into Jordan. 12 Now therefore take you twelve men out of the tribes of Israel, out of every tribe a man. 13 And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests that bear the ark of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters

of Jordan, that the waters of Jordan shall be cut off from the waters that come down from above; and they shall stand upon an heap."

A. The Living God is among you -



Psalms 97:5 "The hills melted like wax at the presence of the LORD, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth."

B. Every molecule and atom in the universe obey His voice:

Joshua 3:13 "And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests that bear the ark of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of Jordan, that the waters of Jordan shall be cut off from the waters that come down from above; and they shall stand upon an heap."

To experience a miracle, prepare for a miracle, believe God's Word, and...

III. Act In Faith -

Joshua 3:14-17 And it came to pass, when the people removed from their tents, to pass over Jordan, and the priests bearing the ark of the covenant before the

people; 15 And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, (for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,) 16 That the waters which came down from above stood and rose up upon an heap very far from the city Adam, that is beside Zaretan: and those that came down

toward the sea of the plain, even the salt sea, failed, and were cut off: and the people passed over right against Jericho. 17 And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on <u>dry ground</u>, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan."



Mark 9:23 "Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth."

Matthew 9:29 "... According to your faith be it unto you."

Joshua 3:17 And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the

midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan."
