How To Avoid

Errors in Judgment

TEXT: Joshua 9:1-8;

Please Open Your Bibles and Let Us Read Together

Joshua 9:1-8 "As soon as all the kings who were beyond the Jordan in the hill country and in the lowland all along the coast of the Great Sea toward Lebanon, the Hittites, the Amorites, the Canaanites, the Perizzites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites, heard of this, 2 they gathered together as one to fight against Joshua and Israel. 3 But when the inhabitants of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done to Jericho and to Ai, 4 they on their part acted with cunning and went and made ready provisions and took worn-out sacks for their donkeys, and 5 with worn-out, patched sandals

on their feet, and worn-out clothes. And all their provisions were dry and crumbly. 6 And they went to Joshua in the camp at Gilgal and said to him and to the men of Israel, "We have come from a distant country, so now make a covenant with us." 7 But the men of Israel said to the

Hivites, "Perhaps you live among us; then how can we make a covenant with you?" 8 They said to Joshua, "We are your servants." And Joshua said to them, "Who are you? And where do you come from?"

Introduction:

When are you most likely to make an error in judgment?

When you <u>least expect</u> to, such as when you are on a spiritual high!

1 Corinthians 10:12 "Wherefore let him that thinketh he standeth take heed lest he fall."





In this study we will find the ingredients needed to avoid errors in judgment.

The First is:

I. CONFER WITH GOD - (9:1-15)

A. The Hivites - GIBEONITES

1. Heard - Joshua 9:3 "And when the inhabitants of Gibeon heard what Joshua had done unto Jericho and to Ai,"

Deuteronomy 20:16 "But of the cities of these people, which the LORD thy God doth give thee for an inheritance, thou shalt save alive nothing that breatheth:"

That was GOD'S S.O.P.!!!

WHY, WHY, WHY?

Deuteronomy 20:18 "That they teach you not to do after all their abominations, which they have done unto their gods; so should ye sin against the LORD your God."

God knew the pagan religions of Canaan were like a spiritual cancer that would infect and destroy the worship of the one true God.

Of course those who trusted in the God of Israel, as Rahab did, would be spared.

When it comes to those with whom we Christians associate, we must always remember the truth found in

- 1 Corinthians 15:33 "Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners." KJV
- 1 Corinthians 15:33 "Do not be deceived: "Bad company ruins good morals." **ESV**

Birds of a feather flock together.

Guilt by Association.

2 Corinthians 2:16 "to one a fragrance from death to death, to the other a fragrance from life to life. Who is sufficient for these things?

(They Also Heard - (the Hivites))

Deuteronomy 20:10-11 "When thou comest nigh unto a city to fight against it, then proclaim peace unto it. 11 And it shall be, if it make thee answer of peace, and open unto thee, then it shall be, that all the people that is found therein shall be tributaries unto

thee, and they shall serve thee."

SO THE HIVITES HAD HEARD, Then they:

2. Hurried -

Joshua 9:6 "And they went to Joshua unto the camp at Gilgal, and said unto him, and to the men of Israel, We be come from a far

country: now therefore make ye a league with us."

3. Hustled -

Joshua 9:9 "And they said unto him, From a very far country thy servants are come because of the name of the LORD thy God: for we have heard the fame of him,

and all that he did in Egypt," Joshua 9:12-13 "This our bread we took hot for our provision out of our houses on the day we came forth to go unto you; but now, behold, it is dry, and it is mouldy: 13 And these bottlesof wine, which we filled, were new; and, behold, they be rent: and these our

garments and our shoes are become old by reason of the very long journey."

4. The Hazard -

Palestinians have no compunction about telling lies and see truth as irrelevant, the former Israeli prime minister Ehud Barak has claimed in an interview. "They are products of a culture in which to tell a lie... creates no dissonance," Mr Barak says. "They don't suffer from the problem of telling lies that exists in Judaeo-Christian culture."

"Truth is seen as an irrelevant category," he says. "There is only that which serves your purpose and that which doesn't. They see themselves as emissaries of a national movement for whom everything is permissible. There is no such thing as 'the truth'."

Ill. Battle of The Bulge (what

Ill. Battle of The Bulge (what Joshua might have said)

By 21 December 1944, the German forces had surrounded Bastogne, which was defended by the 101st Airborne and part of the 10th Armored Division. Conditions inside the perimeter were tough—most of the medical supplies and medical personnel had been captured. Food was scarce, and by 22 December artillery ammunition was restricted to 10 rounds per gun per day. The German commander, requested Bastogne's surrender. When General Anthony McAuliffe, acting commander of the was told of the Nazi demand to surrender, a frustrated McAuliffe responded "Nuts!" After turning to other pressing issues, his staff reminded him that they should reply to the German demand. One officer (Harry Kinnard, then a Lieutenant Colonel) recommended that McAuliffe's initial reply would be "tough to beat." Thus McAuliffe wrote on the paper delivered to the Germans the line he made famous and a morale booster to his troops: "NUTS!" That reply had to be explained, both to the Germans and to

non-American Allies.

The next day, 23 December 1944, the weather conditions started improving, allowing the Allied air forces to attack. Allied air forces also helped the defenders of Bastogne, dropping much-needed suppliesmedicine, food, blankets, and ammunition.

If we confer with God on all our decisions, we take the first step in avoiding errors in judgment.

Second we should...

II. Confirm the Information (9:16-22)

ILL. Never make a major decision without waiting at least three days: Circumstances often change dramatically in three days.

ILL. Christ's Resurrection

A. After Three Days -

Joshua 9:16-17 "And it came to pass at the end of three days after they had made a league with them, that they heard that they were their neighbours, and that they dwelt among them. 17 And the children of Israel journeyed, and came unto their cities on the third day. ..."



B. THE OATH - Never Break Your Word -

Joshua 9:20 "This we will do to them; we will even let them live, lest wrath be upon us, because of the oath which we sware unto them."

Colossians 3:9 "Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;"

ILL. 2 Samuel 21:1-2 "Then there was a famine in the days of David three years, year after year; and David inquired of the LORD. And the LORD answered, It is for

Saul, and for his bloody house, because he slew the Gibeonites. 2 ... (now the Gibeonites were not of the children of Israel, but of the remnant of the Amorites; and the children of Israel unto them: and Saul sought to slay them in his zeal ...)"

2 Samuel 21:9 "And he (David) delivered them (Saul's sons) into the hands of the Gibeonites, and they hanged them in the hill before the LORD: and they fell all seven together, and were put to death in the days of harvest, in the first days, in the beginning of barley harvest."

Galatians 6:7 "Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap."

Like Joshua, we must live with the consequences of our errors in judgment.

We can be forgiven our sins, but we must often live with the consequences for a lifetime.

Even though we have sinned, if we will live in His will in the present and the future, God can do the impossible and make something good come out of our errors in judgment, which brings us to the last point...

III. Claim God's Power to Convert Your Errors in Judgment - (9:23-27)

A. Slaves -

Joshua 9:23 "Now therefore ye are cursed, and there shall none of you be freed from being bondmen, and hewers of wood and drawers of water for the house of my God."

Psalms 84:10 "For a day in thy courts is better than a thousand. I had rather be a doorkeeper (slave) in the house of my God, than to dwell in the tents of wickedness."

B. Saved -

John 8:36 "If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed."

Joshua 9:27 "And Joshua made them that day hewers of wood and drawers of water for the congregation, and for the altar of the LORD, even unto this day, in the place which he should choose."

C. Servants -

Joshua 9:25 "And now, behold, we are in thine hand: as it seemeth good and right unto thee to do unto us, do."

Motthey: 11:20:20 "Take my volte

Matthew 11:29-30 "Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."

Conclusion:

Romans 8:37 "Nay, in all these things we are *more than conquerors* through him that loved us."

To be "more than conquerors" means we go a step beyond defeating our enemy by making our enemy our friend.

If we Confer with God on all our decisions, then

Confirm the information, we can

Claim God's power to Convert our errors in judgment.
