I. The Fence -

- A. The Materials -
 - 1. Chapiters (or caps) 2. Hooks 3. Post 4. Socket (or base) 5. Fine Twined Linen

B. The Measurements = Exodus 27:9-13; 100X50X5 Cubits - 1 cubit = 18" ... Therefore - 150' x 75' x 7'6" Length - 100 cubits = 20 Pillars & 20 Sockets Width (breadth) -50 cubits 10 Pillars & 10 Sockets Height - 5 cubits Fine Twisted Linen

C. The Meaning =

- 1. The Shining White Linen Revelation 19:8; Psalms 92:15; 45:7;
- 2. The Fence Isaiah 64:6; 59:2; Romans 3:23; John 3:14-17;

II. The Hooks of the pillars and their fillets (rods) were of silver: Exodus 27:10;

A. The hooks were attached to the pillar and connected by a silver fillet (rod).

B. This made the wall stable and strong to hang the fine twined linen hangings.

C. Silver symbolizes atonement. It speaks of God's rich grace in providing atonement, a covering for sin. Romans 3:24-25;

D. Silver is the price of life

1. Jesus (The Lamb of God) was sold for thirty pieces of silver – John 1:29; Matthew 26:15; 1 Corinthians 5:7;

2. Romans 5:6, 18;

3. An allusion is made of this silver in - 1 Peter 3:18;
