  - **A. Its Significance** Leviticus 16:12, 14;

### B. Its Materials –

- 1. Wood <u>Septuagint</u> (the first translation ever made of the Old Testament into Greek) it is always translated "incorruptible wood."
  - 2. Gold This prefigured His Divine nature.
- **C. Its Contents** Hebrews 9:4; "The ark of the covenant overlaid round about with gold, wherein was the golden pot that had manna, and Aaron's rod that budded, and the tables of the covenant."
  - 1 Kings 8:9: "There was nothing in the ark save the two tables of stone."
    - 1. The manna foreshadowed Christ as the Bread of life.
    - 2. "Aaron's rod that budded." Priestly grace to sustain us.
    - 3. The two tables of stone on which were written the Ten Commandments.

# **D. Its Coverings -** Numbers 4:5-6;

- 1. First, the Ark was wrapped in the "covering veil."
- 2. Second, over the veil was placed "the covering of badgers' skins."
- 3. Third, the external covering of the Ark was "a cloth wholly of blue."
