1 Timothy 5:3-8

1. The church is to place a high priority on **CARING** for those within the church family that are in need.
2. Those who follow God are to *"...learn to do good; seek justice, correct oppression; bring justice to the fatherless, **PLEAD** the widow's cause."* Isaiah 1:17
3. *"Beware of the scribes...who devour widows' houses and for a pretense make long prayers. They will receive the **GREATER** condemnation."* Luke 20:46-47
4. In the **GREEK** language the meaning of the word "widow" is open-ended with no definition of the cause for becoming a widow, meaning it can define women who have lost their husbands through death, desertion, divorce or imprisonment.
