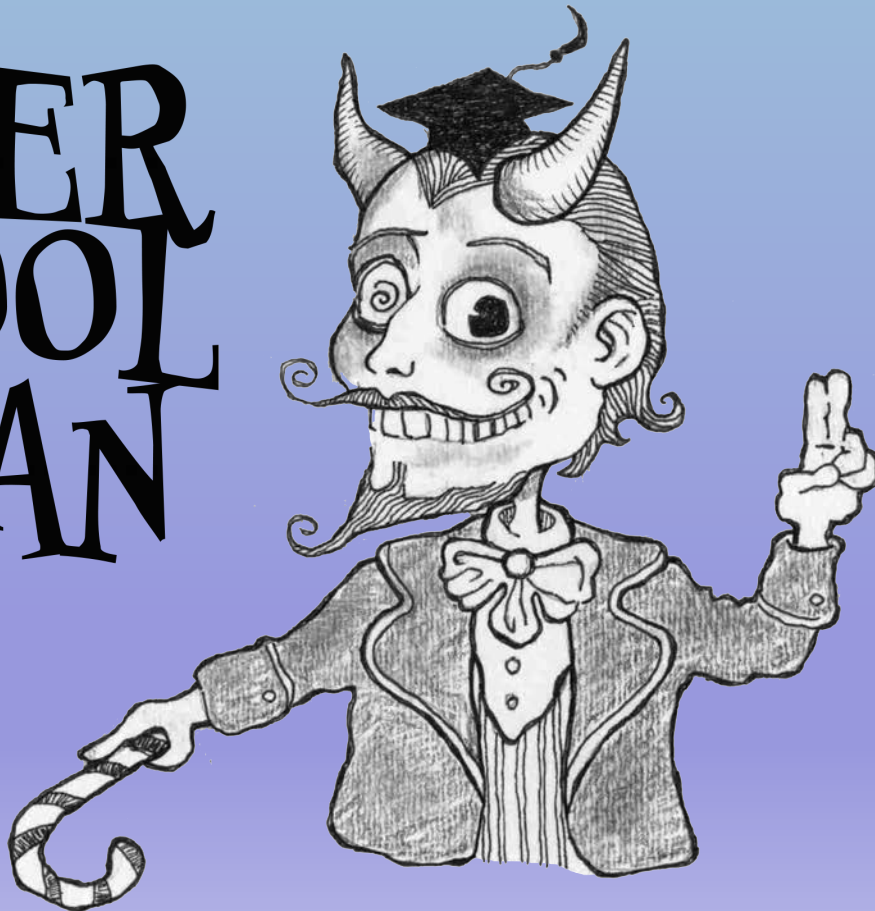

I. The Mess

The record of his Grandfather, Manasseh (from 2 Kings 21)

21:2 He did evil in the sight of the LORD, according to the abominations of the nations whom the LORD dispossessed before the sons of Israel.

1. He rebuilt the high places which Hezekiah his father had destroyed
2. He erected altars for Baal
3. He made an Asherah, as Ahab king of Israel had done (a female deity – the moon goddess – presented as consort of Baal – worship noted for sensuality – Priests and priestesses practiced divination and fortune-telling)
4. He worshiped all the host of heaven and served them
5. He built altars in the House of the LORD
6. He built altars for the hosts of heaven in the two courts of the Temple
7. He made his son pass through the fire (Sacrificed in fire)
8. He practiced witchcraft
9. He used divination
10. He dealt with mediums and spiritists
11. He set the Asherah in the house of the LORD

The record of his Father

2 Kings 21:19-24

Amon was twenty-two years old when he became king, and he reigned two years in Jerusalem... He did evil in the sight of the Lord, as Manasseh his father had done.

For he walked in all the way that his father had walked, and served the idols that his father had served and worshiped them. So he forsook the Lord, the God of his fathers, and did not walk in the way of the Lord. The servants of Amon conspired against him and killed the king in his own house. Then the people of the land killed all those who had conspired against King Amon, and the people of the land made Josiah his son king in his place.

II. Men of God

Kings 22:3

Now in the eighteenth year of King Josiah, the king sent Shaphan, the son of Azaliah the son of Meshullam the scribe, to the house of the Lord saying, “Go up to Hilkiah the high priest...

1 Corinthians 15:33

Do not be deceived: “Bad company corrupts good morals.”

The opposite of that would also be true, “Good company helps to build good morals”.

1. Shapan, the scribe
2. Hilkiah, the high priest

III. The Moment

2 Kings 22:4-11

1. A strong conviction that he had to clean and repair the Temple
2. Verse 4 – He levied a tax for the repair and restoration of the Temple
3. Verse 5 – He laid out a strategy to accomplish the repair
4. Verse 5 – He delegated authority to the competent people to get the job done (with full confidence)

Isaiah 40:6-8 (NASB)

A voice says, “Call out.” Then he answered,
“What shall I call out?”

All flesh is grass, and all its loveliness is like
the flower of the field.

The grass withers, the flower fades, When the
breath of the Lord blows upon it;

surely the people are grass. The grass

1 Peter 1:24-25 (NASB)

Then the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, Ahikam the son of Shaphan, Achbor the son of Micaiah, Shaphan the scribe, and Asaiah the king's servant saying, "Go, inquire of the Lord for me and the people and all Judah concerning the words of this book that has been found, for great is the wrath of the Lord that burns against us, because our fathers have not listened to the words of this book, to do according to all that is written concerning us."

Isaiah 55:11 (NKJV)

So shall My word be that goes forth from
My mouth; It shall not return to Me void,
But it shall accomplish what I please,
And it shall prosper in the thing for which
I sent it.

Hebrews 4:12 (NASB)

For the word of God is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

Note how the prophetess describes Josiah....

1. your heart was tender
2. you humbled yourself before the Lord
3. you have torn your clothes
4. (you have) wept before Me

IV. Mercy

2 Kings 22:20

“Therefore, behold, I will gather you to your fathers, and you will be gathered to your grave in peace, and your eyes will not see all the evil which I will bring on this place.” So they brought back word to the king.

V. A Movement

- A. He gathered the people for a public reading of the Word
- B. He made a covenant before the people and encouraged the people to join in.
- C. He removed everything idolatrous from the Temple
- D. He defiled pagan places of worship
- E. He broke down idols
- F. He removed altars to false gods on roof tops of Jerusalem
- G. He dug up bones of false priests and burned the bones on pagan altars to defile them
- H. AND, he restored the celebration of the Passover.

2 Chronicles 35:7

Josiah contributed to the lay people, to all who were present, flocks of lambs and young goats, all for the Passover offerings, numbering 30,000 plus 3,000 bulls; these were from the king's possessions.

2 Chronicles 35:16-19

So all the service of the LORD was prepared on that day to celebrate the Passover, and to offer burnt offerings on the altar of the LORD according to the command of King Josiah. Thus the sons of Israel who were present celebrated the Passover at that time, and the Feast of Unleavened Bread seven days. There had not been celebrated a Passover like it in Israel since the days of Samuel the prophet; nor had any of the kings of Israel celebrated such a Passover as Josiah did with the priests, the Levites, all Judah and Israel who were present, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem. In the eighteenth year of Josiah's reign this Passover was celebrated.
