13 ¶ Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men.
14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hid.
15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light to all that are in the house.
16 ¶ I am not that I am come to destroy the law, and the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil.
17 ¶ I say unto you, Whosoever therefore shall break one of these least commandments, and shall teach men so, he shall be called the least in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever shall do and teach them, the same shall be called great in the kingdom of heaven.

22 ¶ If thy brother be grieved with thee, go and be reconciled to him: so shalt thou with thy Father be reconciled.
23 ¶ If thou offer thy gift at the altar, and there remember that thy brother hath aught against thee, leave thy gift there at the altar, go first and be reconciled to thy brother, and then come and offer thy gift.
24 ¶ Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison.
25 ¶ Verily I say unto thee, Thou shalt by no means come out thence, till thou hast paid the uttermost farthing.
26 ¶ Ye have heard that it was said by them of old time, Thou shalt not commit adultery: I say unto you, That whosoever looketh on a woman to lust after her hath committed adultery with her already in his heart.
