

Benchmarks Of Christian

Character

For godly grief produces a repentance that leads to salvation without regret, whereas worldly grief produces death.

God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.

Whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

Praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance

Friendship with the world is enmity with God. Therefore whoever wishes to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk, that by it you may grow up into salvation.

I am the vine; you are the branches. Whoever abides in me and I in him, he it is that bears much fruit, for apart from me you can do nothing. ... 8 By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and so prove to be my disciples.

Not everyone who says to me, "Lord, Lord", will enter the kingdom of heaven, but the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.

If anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come. All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation.

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment.

A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.

Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the desires of the flesh and the desires of the eyes and pride of life—is not from the Father but is from the world. And the world is passing away along with its desires, but whoever does the will of God abides forever.

Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.

The fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

The works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God.

All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.
