C. RESULTS IN OVERCOMING Luke 16:10

We really don't know what persecution is. We are beginning to read, see and feel what it is like or the way it will be, by observing what is happening in our own country. (read the excerpts about what is happening in USA) John 16:33

LEVELS OF PERSECUTION

- 1. Slander, insult, (once or twice)
- 2. Intimidation, bullying (ongoing)
- 3. Threats, risks
- 4. Damage, harm, injury (repeatedly)
- 5. Torture, physical, sexual abuse (severe and repeatedly)
- 6. Killing, death, murder

GENOCIDE- the gravest crime against humanity, the mass attempt at exterminating a group of people such As Hitler did against the Jewish people. It is believed that genocide is being attempted today against religious groups, especially Christians. (Give examples) The ongoing war in Syria and rise of ISIS in Iraq have created the largest refugee crisis in history, forcing more than 4 million Christians from their homes.
