

Because of Unbelief

Hebrews 4:1-2

We should fear,
therefore, while the promise of
entering his rest still stands, let
us fear lest any of you should
seem to have failed to reach it.

PSALM 115:6

They have ears,
but do not hear.

MATTHEW 11:13-15

For all the Prophets and the Law prophesied until John, and if you are willing to accept it, he is Elijah who is to come. **He who has ears to hear, let him hear.**

EXODUS 33:3

Go up to a land flowing with milk and honey; but **I will not go up among you**, lest I consume you on the way, for you are a stiff-necked people.

ROMANS 1:19-20

For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made.

So they are without excuse.

ROMANS 10:14-17

How then will they call on him *meaning Jesus* in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent?

As it is written, “How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!” (Isaiah 52:7) But they have not all obeyed the gospel.

For Isaiah says, “Lord, who has believed what he has heard from us?” (Isaiah 53:1) **So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ.**

HEBREWS 12:1-2

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, **looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith**, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.

MATTHEW 7:21-23

Not everyone who says to me, “Lord, Lord,” will enter the kingdom of heaven, but **the one who does the will of my Father who is in heaven.** On that day many will say to me, “Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name, and cast out demons in your name, and do many mighty works in your name?” And then will I declare to them, “I never knew you; depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.”

JOHN 6:29 & 40

This is the **work of God**, that you believe
in Him whom He has sent.

For this is the **will of my Father**, that
everyone who looks on the Son and believes
in him should have eternal life, and
I will raise him up on the last day.

Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and **I will give you rest**. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls.

For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.

HEBREWS 4:1-2

For good news came to us just as to them, but the message they heard did not benefit them, because they were not united by faith with those who listened.
