

Hebrews 7:20 - 28









God and Priest

For when there is a change in the priesthood, there is necessarily a change in the law as well.

Melchizedek king of Salem brought out bread and wine. (He was priest of God Most High.) And he blessed him and said, "Blessed be Abram by God Most High, Possessor of heaven and earth; and blessed be God Most High, who has delivered your enemies into your hand!" And Abram gave him a tenth of everything.

The LORD has sworn and will not change his mind, "You are a priest forever after the order of Melchizedek."

HEBREWS 7

- v. 1 to 10 Teaches the greatness of Melchizedek
 - v. 11 to 19 Teaches that the new priesthood supersedes the old
 - v. 20-28 Shows us the superiority of the new priesthood.

Christ has accomplished for us what the Levitical priesthood never could.

Then bring near to you Aaron your brother, and his sons with him, from among the people of Israel, to serve me as priests

So when God desired to show more convincingly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeable character of his purpose, he guaranteed it with an oath

Send the boy with me, and we will arise and go, that we may live and not die, both we and you and also our little ones. I will be a pledge of his safety. From my hand you shall require him. If I do not bring him back to you and set him before you, then let me bear the blame forever.

Now therefore, as soon as I come to your servant my father, and the boy is not with us, then, as his life is bound up in the boy's life, as soon as he sees that the boy is not with us, he will die, and your servants will bring down the gray hairs of your servant our father with sorrow to Sheol. For your servant became a pledge of safety for the boy to my father, saying, "If I do not bring him back to you, then I shall bear the blame before my father all my life." Now therefore, please let your servant remain instead of the boy as a servant to my lord, and let the boy go back with his brothers. For how can I go back to my father if the boy is not with me?

Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need

This is the will of him who sent me, that I should lose nothing of all that he has given me, but raise it up on the last day. For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day.

Who will not fear, O Lord, and glorify your name? For you alone are holy.

Just are you, O Holy One, who is and who was ...

For you will not abandon my soul to Hades, or let your Holy One see corruption.

Therefore he says also in another psalm, "You will not let your Holy One see corruption." (Psalm 16:10)

Because he poured out his soul to death and was numbered with the transgressors; yet he bore the sin of many, and makes intercession for the transgressors.

For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

In these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world. He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high.

Therefore he had to be made like his brothers in every respect, so that he might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people. For because he himself has suffered when tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted.

I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. I do not nullify the grace of God, for if righteousness were through the law, then Christ died for no purpose.

Jesus is incomparable in greatness, inexhaustible in resource, infinite in patience, infallible in wisdom and loves each person as no other can.
