But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing upon themselves swift destruction. And many will follow their sensuality, and because of them the way of truth will be blasphemed. And in their greed they will exploit you with false words.

TITUS 1:7-9

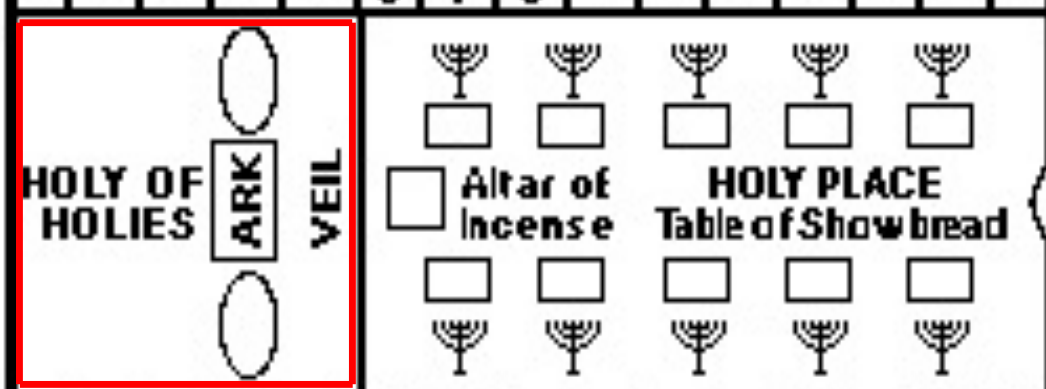

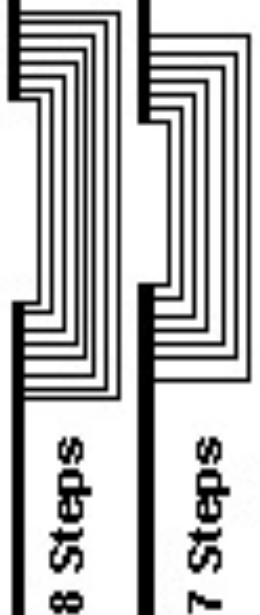
GREAT COURT OR OUTER COURT

“The rope on the high priest legend is just that: a legend. It has obscure beginnings in the Middle Ages and keeps getting repeated. It cannot be found anywhere in the Bible, Apocrypha, the Dead Sea Scrolls, Josephus, the Pseudepigrapha, the Talmud, Mishna or any other Jewish source. It just is not there.”

Aaron wore a blue ephod with bells sown on its hem as found in Exodus and he wore this colorful robe and ephod when he entered the **Holy Place**, which is **NOT** the **Holy of Holies** as defined in Leviticus.
