

Result

Immediately *Jesus* left the synagogue and entered the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John. Now Simon's mother-in-law lay ill with a fever, and **immediately** they told him about her. And ***Jesus* came and took her by the hand and lifted her up, and the fever left her**, and she began to serve them.

Mark 1:29-31

Zacharias asked for a writing tablet and wrote, “His name is John.” And they all wondered. And **immediately** his mouth was opened and his tongue loosed, and he spoke, blessing God. And fear came on all their neighbors. And all these things were talked about through all the hill country of Judea, and all who heard them laid them up in their hearts, saying, “What then will this child be?” For the hand of the Lord was with him.

Luke 1:63-66

While *Jesus* was in one of the cities, there came a man full of leprosy. And when he saw Jesus, he fell on his face and begged him, “Lord, **if you will**, you can make me clean.” And Jesus stretched out his hand and touched him, saying, “I will; be clean.” And **immediately** the leprosy left him.

Luke 5:12-13

Jesus said to the man who was paralyzed—

Saved

Rulers of the people and elders, if we are being examined today concerning a good deed done to a crippled man, by what means this man has been **healed** (*sozo or saved*)

Acts 4:8-9

Let it be known to all of you and to all the people of Israel that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead—by him this man is standing before you well. This Jesus is the stone that was rejected by you, the builders, which has become the cornerstone. And **there is salvation in no one else**, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be **saved** (sozo)
