1. Matthew 5:10-12 "Blessed are those who are ____persecuted____ for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Blessed are you when others revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account. Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for so they __persecuted____ the prophets who were before you." 2. More Christians were martyred for their faith in the 20 th century than all the centuries combined. 3. Hatred, excommunication and murder - they may be the **cost** of discipleship. 4. Persecution from the secular world we expect. Persecution from religious people and *churches* is more difficult; but this was the case for Jesus, the disciples, and the early church and is a threat today. 5. When we evaluate a church or a pastor or a person who claims to be Christian - the Bible is the standard for our judgment. 6. God has a purpose in persecution and Jesus forewarns/forearms believers so they will not fall away from their faith. He warns us so that our faith will more than endure-it will be __strengthened__. 7. A Christian can ___rejoice ____ in persecution because it shows this fallen world the supernatural power of God in the believer's life.
