



Instructions To The Church

Main Points

1 Timothy

I am writing these things to you so that, if I delay, you may know how one ought to behave in the household of God, which is the church of the living God, a pillar and buttress of the truth.

I thank him who has given me strength, Christ Jesus our Lord, because he judged me faithful, appointing me to his service.

For to this end we toil and strive, because we have our hope set on the living God, who is the Savior of all people, especially of those who believe.

Timothy remain at Ephesus so that you may charge certain persons not to teach any different doctrine, nor to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies, which promote speculations rather than the stewardship from God that is by faith.



The saying is trustworthy and deserving of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners.



I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people ... that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way.

I desire then that in every place the men should pray, lifting holy hands without anger or quarreling; likewise also that women ... with modesty and self-control ... profess godliness with good works.



The saying is trustworthy:

If anyone aspires to the office of overseer, he desires a noble task.

Train yourself for godliness; for while bodily training is of some value, godliness is of value in every way, as it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come.

Keep a close watch on yourself and on the teaching. Persist in this, for by so doing you will save both yourself and your hearers.



How then will they call on him in whom they have not believed? And how are they to believe in him of whom they have never heard? And how are they to hear without someone preaching? And how are they to preach unless they are sent? As it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!"

Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourselves.

If anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for members of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

Teach and urge these things. If anyone teaches a different doctrine and does not agree with the sound words of our Lord Jesus Christ and the teaching that accords with godliness, he is puffed up with conceit and understands nothing.

... flee these things. Instead we are call to "Pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, steadfastness, gentleness. Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called and about which you made the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

We are to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, thus storing up treasure for themselves as a good foundation for the future, so that they may take hold of that which is truly life.

Call To Duty

Call To Holiness

O Timothy ... Avoid the irreverent babble and contradictions of what is falsely called "knowledge."



Avoid irreverent babble, for it will lead people into more and more ungodliness, and their talk will spread like gangrene.

Therefore, if anyone cleanses himself from what is dishonorable he will be a vessel for honorable use, set apart as holy, useful to the master of the house, ready for every good work.

False prophets also arose among the people, just as there will be false teachers among you, who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Master who bought them, bringing upon themselves swift destruction. And many will follow their sensuality, and because of them the way of truth will be blasphemed.

Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who has no need to be ashamed, rightly handling the word of truth.

What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?
