

But **Aaron's staff swallowed up their staffs**. Still Pharaoh's heart was hardened, and he would not listen to them, as the LORD had said.



Divination

Is the art or practice that seeks to foresee or foretell future events or discover hidden knowledge usually by the interpretation of omens or by the aid of supernatural powers.

It is witchcraft. Divination comes from the same root word as divine – Simon thought he had divine qualities.

Enchanter

Because of the similarity of this Hebrew word to the word for snake, many scholars are of the opinion that there is a connection to snake charming. Others believe that since there is a similarity of hissing sounds of enchanters as they chant and snakes that respond, this accounts for the similarity of the words.

Sorcerer - Magician - Witch

As a **sorcerer** or **magician** or **witch**,

Simon would have claimed he had the

power to communicate with the dead

and spirits. In Samuel chapter 28 this

person is called a medium and in

Deuteronomy 18:11 a necromancer



Even Simon himself believed, and after being baptized he continued with Philip. And seeing signs and great miracles performed, he was amazed

Now when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover Feast, many believed in his name when they saw the signs that he was doing. But Jesus on his part did not entrust himself to them, because he knew all people and needed no one to bear witness about man, for he himself knew what was in man.
