According to the Bible, the conquest of Jericho occurred in approximately 1440 B.C.

The miraculous nature of the conquest has caused some scholars to dismiss the story as folklore.

Does archaeology support the biblical account?

Over the past century four prominent archaeologists have excavated the site: Carl Watzinger from 1907-1909, John Garstang in the 1930's, Kathleen Kenyon from 1952-1958, and currently Bryant Wood. The result of their work has been remarkable.

First, they discovered that Jericho had an impressive system of fortifications.

Surrounding the city was a retaining wall fifteen feet high and at its top was an eight foot brick wall strengthened from behind by an earthen rampart.

Domestic structures were found behind this first wall.

Another brick wall enclosed the rest of the city.

The domestic structures found between the two walls is consistent with Joshua's description of Rahab's quarters (Joshua 2:15).

Archeologists also found that in one part of the city, large piles of bricks were found at the base of both the inner and outer walls, indicating a

sudden collapse of the fortifications. Scholars feel that an earthquake, which may also explain the damming of the Jordan in the biblical account, caused this collapse.

The collapsed bricks formed a ramp by which an invader might easily enter the city (Joshua 6:20).

Within the upper wall was an area of approximately six acres, while the total area of the upper city and fortification system was 50% larger, or about nine acres.

Based on the archaeologist's rule of thumb of 200 persons per acre, the population of the upper city would have been about 1,200.

However, from excavations carried out by a German team in the first decade of this century, we know that people were also living on the embankment between the upper and lower city walls.

In addition, those Canaanites living in surrounding villages would have fled to Jericho for safety.

Thus, we can assume that there were several thousand people inside the walls when the Israelites came against the city.

The citizens of Jericho were well prepared for a siege. A copious spring which provided water for ancient, as well as modern, Jericho lay inside the city walls. At the time of the attack,

the harvest had just been taken in (Joshua 3:15), so the citizens had an abundant supply of food. This has been borne out by many large jars full of grain found in the Canaanite homes by John Garstang in his excavation in the 1930s and also by Kenyon. With a plentiful food supply and ample water, the inhabitants of Jericho could have held out for perhaps several years.

the seventh day, Scripture tells us that the wall "fell down flat" (Joshua 6:20). The Hebrew here carries the suggestion that it "fell beneath itself." Is there evidence for such an event at Jericho? It turns out that there is ample evidence that the mud brick city wall collapsed and was deposited at the base of the stone retaining wall at the time the

city met its end.

Jericho is stated to be the longest continually inhabited city on earth.

The main massive city walls were wide enough to drive two chariots side-by-side, and were virtually impregnable by ancient standards.

The name *Jericho* means "Moon City", and was probably the center of worship for the Canaanites moon god.

The inhabitants of Jericho know the Israelites are about to attack, so...

Joshua 6:1 "...Jericho was straightly shut up ... none went out, and none came in."


